Mission

Serious JuJu is an indoor skatepark. We see, feed, and strengthen kids; We celebrate skateboarders; We serve Christ. Like helmets, masks are uncomfortable, but it gets easier. Jesus calls us to love God and love neighbor as we love ourselves. During a global health pandemic, masking up is a scientifically significant way we can help reduce spread and thereby love our neighbor.

On March 16, 2020, Serious JuJu followed Kalispell School District and closed our warehouse to skateboarding. As the governor initiated stay-at-home orders, JuJu organized curb-side food bag pickup and Saturday Food Box Deliveries. In April, JuJu delivered at home skate boxes and ramps encouraging online skate comps. In June, JuJu returned to reopened Woodland Skate Park on Friday Nights. In July and August, JuJu recommenced Friday Skate Night outside behind Bethlehem Lutheran Church.

Following Labor Day, JuJu's warehouse will re-open to small, reserved skate groups.

5-6 Skaters

2 Volunteers

If less than 3 skaters, that week's skate night canceled. If both volunteers unavailable, skate night canceled. A parent may offer to substitute volunteer alongside a JuJu trained volunteer.

To protect one another's health, ALL skaters will mask up upon entry and any time they are not actively skating or eating. At the close of the skate session, each skater will clean their table, dispose of food/trash, and help sanitize the skate park for the next group. Volunteers will wear a mask at all times unless eating/drinking. A reduction of skaters will allow for better social distancing. Fans will and an air purifier in the food area will be used to circulate air, dispersing plumes expressed air from any asymptomatic persons experiencing covid. All heavily used surfaces will be wiped between user groups.

Weekly Skate Group consisting of the Same Skaters and Pair of Volunteers Up to 6 skaters will pick a 1.5hr weekly timeframe to skate and secure 2 JuJu-Trained Volunteers. Skate Group identifies a representative CONNECTOR. The connector's job is to communicate between skaters and volunteers AND volunteers and skaters.

Limited Open Skate allows for skaters without regular routines or without a skate group or newbies to skate. Sessions for Open Skate are posted and limited to 6 Skaters with 24hr advance reservation. Following each skate, all spots reopen.

Volunteers for Skate Nights

More volunteers are needed.

Instead of serving 70-80 kids a week in 2 nights over 3 sessions, we will eventually be creating 10-12 1.5hr small skate sessions to serve the same number of skaters. We seek the best pairing of volunteers with every skate group. Parents may wish to be trained to volunteer for their child's skate. For many reasons, we may wish to hand select skaters over 18 to train and serve as skate coach volunteers alongside an adult.

Skate Times

Over time, Pastor Miriam will become available Tuesday up to 3 sessions: 4:00-5:30pm, 6:00-7:30pm, 8:00-9:30pm; and up to 3 sessions on Thursday: 4:00-5:30pm, 6:00-7:30pm, 8:00-9:30pm. Daytime skate times can be arranged Monday or Wednesday for homeschool students. Additional skate sessions will be approved upon request and availability of volunteers.

Training

- 1. First, those interested in volunteering will discuss interest with Pastor Miriam.
- 2. Next, attend online training. Online Training will be held Friday, Sept 4 at noon.
- 3. All volunteers will need to complete and pass a background check.

 Any pertinent items in history will be discussed with Pastor Miriam or JuJu Board President to determine fit.
- 4. All volunteers will complete a <u>2-hr online sexual assault prevention training</u>.

Health & Safety

At sign in, all guests check through symptom list. Any guest presenting sick, will not be permitted. Masks are required while not skating or eating. Disposable Masks will be provided. Evidence now shows bandanas are not effective.

Hand Sanitizer Stations will be set up throughout.

6ft markings placed at key areas in entryway, cage & dining area.

Gloves & cleaning supplies will be readily available.

Fans will be used throughout the skate session to circulate and disperse air.

1 Parent/Partner Guest may enter JuJu at a time, masked and remaining in the food area for viewing skating.

To protect volunteers, no rides will be offered to or from JuJu.

If some gets COVID, the skate session will be notified and suspended for 2-weeks.
